Matt also included a drawing of how to construct a small pier section that would install in front of the boat to place the dock box on. There was much discussion regarding size of box, cost of box, construction of pier and how

difficult it would be to remove if needed, etc. Lou made a motion to allow Matt to install his dock box, as proposed, to be used as a prototype for future installations and to act as a visual aid for further board approval. Andrea seconded the motion. A vote was taken with all Ayes except Becky, who voted Nay. The motion carried.
